Upon successful completion of the course, students are expected to: have a concise knowledge of the basic events of Modern Greek History, to be familiar with the basic interpretative approaches of this historical period, discover analogies between historical events of different periods, argue and develop their thinking by negotiating historical events and their interpretations, trace the human presence and action behind events and historical structures, recognize both rational design and chance in the historical process, recognize the role of the Great Powers in any historical outcome, understand the catalytic importance of the powers, recognize the inseparable interconnection and interdependence of the political, military, social and economic spheres, the political, economic, social, cultural and symbolic elements in history, understand the distinction and the interconnection between micro-history and general (national or international) history, use the knowledge of the historical period acquired to understand other historical periods, use the knowledge of the period of history they have acquired to understand other periods of history and life itself and to formulate judgements expressing reflection on relevant historical, political, social, scientific or ethical issues, use this knowledge and understanding in their professional field to a high degree, be able to communicate information, ideas, problems and solutions to both specialist and lay people non-specialist audiences
